“We knew when we walked in the door, this was the house of our dreams,” says Nonie Walder of her house in Dartmouth where she has lived for 60+ years. Nonie and her husband Rick met while students at University of Rhode Island. Rick was studying engineering and Nonie majored in education with a minor in music. They settled in New Bedford; then found that perfect house in Dartmouth. Along the way, they raised four children, the first three born in four years! “I sometimes wonder how I did it,” she admits, “but they turned out just fine.” After working for NASA, Rick found his calling as a professor at what was then New Bedford Institute of Textiles and Technology and later became UMass Dartmouth. Nonie was also busy, becoming director of a nursery school and then teaching 6th grade and later high school math. Nicknamed “Boom-Boom,” Nonie was a percussionist and bass player for about 40 years in the Dartmouth Community Band. Rick died in 2006, but with the support of her children, Nonie has been able to stay independent in her beloved home. She also relies on Coastal Neighbors volunteers. “I can count on these lovely people to get me to my dialysis appointments three days a week,” she says. But it’s not just transportation she appreciates – it’s the friendships and time with caring people that make Coastal Neighbors’ help so important in her life.
